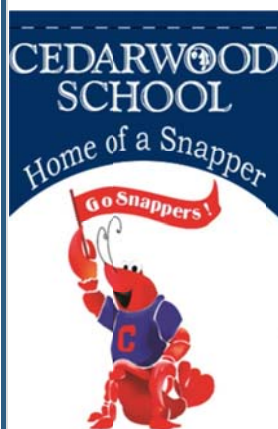


Preschool Students Dress for the Cold Weather
